

Holly Point Campground (Registered Campers Only) **FALLS LAKE RECREATION AREA**

WELCOME to the Holly Point Recreation Area. Holly Point is a component of Falls Lake State Recreation Area and is a family campground consisting of 158 campsites, five shower houses, two swimming beaches and a boat ramp. Handicapped campsites are available on site numbers 19, 51, 91, 132 and 137. Park information is listed below as well as throughout the park.

Holly Point Campground is designated for camping only and is located off New Light Road north of NC 98. There are several "day-use-only" areas on Falls Lake. Beaverdam, Sandling Beach and the Highway 50 Boat Launch Recreation Areas are all located off NC 50. Rollingview Recreation Area, located off Baptist Road off NC 98 near Durham, has a family campground, group campground and a day use area. Shinleaf Recreation Area is a primitive-walk-in campground located off New Light Road north of NC 98. B.W. Wells Group Camp is a walk-in group campground located on Bent Road, off Bud Morris Road near Wake Forest.

PARK GATES ARE CLOSED AND LOCKED AT CLOSING TIMES.

Gates are not opened after hours except in medical or law enforcement emergencies. In case of emergencies, campers are provided with emergency numbers and there are pay phones located in the park.

General Rules and Regulations:

1. Campsites are on a first-come basis unless there are reserved. Campsites cannot be held by placing coolers, lawn chairs, or other equipment for yourself or others. A tent or camper must be set up on the site in order to claim occupancy.
2. Campers can stay up to 14 days in a 30-day period within Falls Lake State Recreation Area. For example, a camper cannot stay at Holly Point for 14 days and then move to Rollingview.
3. Swimming and fires are permitted in designated areas only.
4. Campground quiet hours are 10:00 pm to 7:00 am.
5. Alcoholic beverages, firearms, fireworks and explosives are prohibited inside State Parks.
6. Pets are required to be on a leash 6 foot or shorter at all times and are not allowed on beaches.
7. All camping equipment, vehicles and tents must be kept within the gravel portion of the campsite. Up to six people and two vehicles are allowed on a campsite.
8. Destruction or removal of plants and animals is prohibited.
9. Campground checkout time is 3:00 pm.
10. All NC General Statutes, NC State Park Rules and Regulations are applicable in the park.
