1. Join Mendeley.
2. Put all your papers (at least 20) into your account on Mendeley.
3. Join the BCB group Dr H has created.
4. Add at least one paper you like to the BCB group papers (related to BCB).
5. Add a contact (choose someone from our class if you're shy ☺)
6. Install the Import to Mendeley tool to your browser
7. Import at least one PDF from the web into your library
