COURSE DESCRIPTION

Information Assurance is a broader concept than (computerized) information security. It deals with aspects of data integrity, privacy, paper and human security issues, and security from several perspectives: legal issues, technical tools and methods, social and ethical concerns, and organization's policies and procedures, and standards.

COURSE GOALS

This course is a broad introduction to Information Assurance. When you have finished this course, you should expect to be able to a) identify security issues for an organization, particularly with reference to human issues, and b) create appropriate policies and procedures documents for an organization.
