ArchivesSpace: Basic Facts

- Began in Sept. 2009 as **project** supported by the libraries of New York University, the University of Illinois at Urbana-Champaign, and the University of California, San Diego and funded by the Andrew W. Mellon Foundation.
- **Instigated for integrating** the best features of the Archivists' Toolkit and Archon applications into a next-generation archives information management system
- Became in Sept 2013 a **member-supported program**, having an organizational home at LYRASIS, a governance board and advisory councils, and a dedicated staff.
